

1. How to open Photoshop CS3 and locate and open an image.

At the end of this lesson you will be able to demonstrate how to open Photoshop CS3 by selecting it from the current set of programs on your PC. Once the program opens you will be able to locate and open an image from the **Open dialog box** by navigating to the *File* drop down menu and selecting the *Open* option.

Requirements

Go to the newly created folder called "PhotoPrep" and find "Subfolder1" and "Subfolder2". Rename them to "OriginalImages", and "EditedImages" respectively.

Download the photo called "**OriginalImage1.jpg**" and save to the folder called "**OriginalImages**".

Step One:

To open Photoshop CS3, click **Start > All Programs > Adobe Master Collection CS3 > Adobe Photoshop CS3**

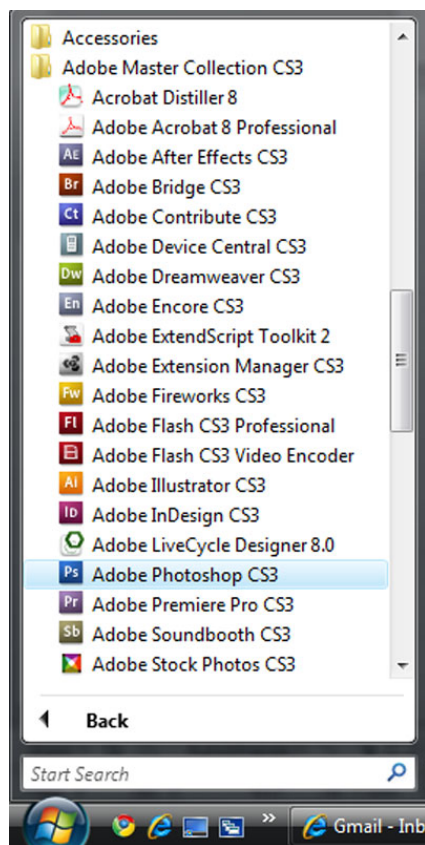


Figure 1.1 Opening Photoshop CS3

Step Two:

Navigate to the folder PhotoPrep > OriginalImages.

Step Three:

Select the image called “**OriginalImage1.jpg**” and press the “**Open**” button.

The image is now open on your screen.

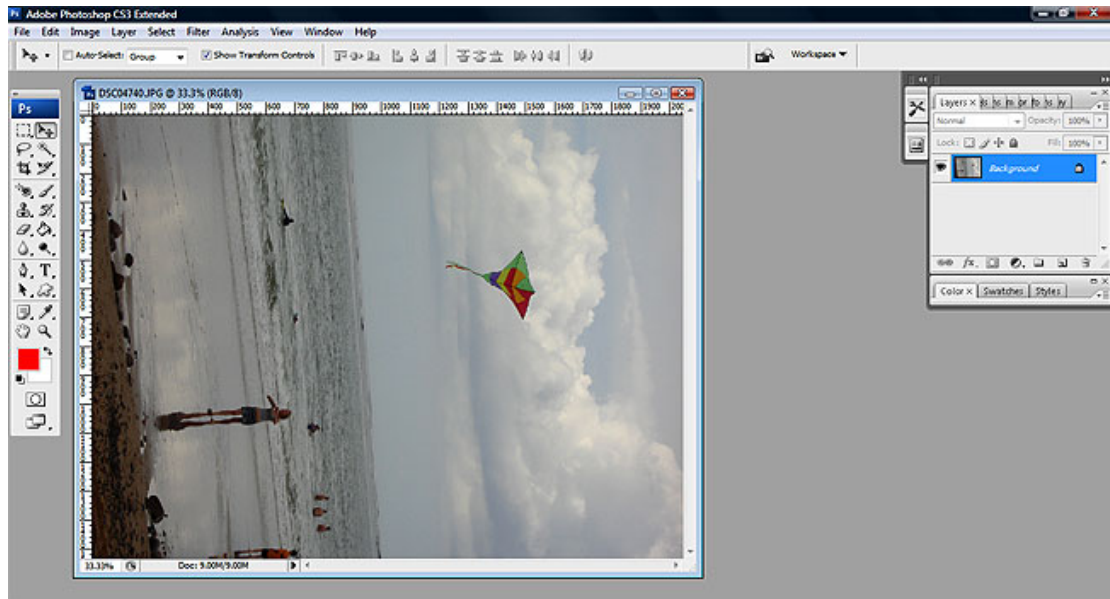


Figure 1.2 Photoshop Interface.
