

## Pictures To Exe – Frequently Asked Questions.

*Question 1:*

### **What size images should I use in Pictures To Exe?**

Images should be in JPED format 1024x768 or 1280x960, 160-500 KB.

Images that will be used in a deep zoom or a long pan need to be sized differently. For example if you want to zoom in to an image to 200% you must size your image to 2048x1536 pixels.

### **What kind of music files should I use in Pictures To Exe?**

Background music files should be MP3 files (don't use WAV music files).

*Question 3:*

### **How many slides can I include in my slide show?**

Up to 20000 slides (unregistered version is limited to 10 slides).

*Question 4:*

### **What is synchronization?**

In PTE, the term **synchronisation** is used to describe the linking of slides with an associated sound track file.

Example – A slide show that contains 30 slides each set to a duration of 10 seconds (including the transition time for each slide). The total length of the show will thus be  $30 \times 10 = 300$  seconds. A sound track with a length is 600 seconds is added to the project. If the **Timeline** window is opened, it will be seen that the slides end after 300 seconds, even although the **synchronise music and slides** radio button is ticked. To ensure that the slides are equally distributed over the 600 sec duration of the sound track, the **Arrange All Points** button in the **Timeline** window needs to be clicked. The slides will now be distributed at 20 sec intervals equally over the 600 sec sound track and the show will be synchronised.
