

Step Three:

Move the blue triangle to the start of the other grey line and select the tab called **Animation**. Select the button called “**Create new keyframe here**” – a new keyframe is inserted on the time line. The pink circle represents the keyframe.

Step Four:

Now that this keyframe is active change its opacity to zero. Go to the **Animation** tab and look for **Opacity**. Select the down arrow button and move the slider bar to zero. (We want the image to change from colour to black and white)

Step Five:

Press the **Play** button to see the flower image transition from colour to monochrome.

Step Six:

Select the **Close** button to close the Objects and Animation window.

Step Seven:

It is time to check your work so select the **Preview** button on the Controls Button Panel.

Well done, you have now created your first simple animation.
